DOLL HEIGHT: 9 INCHES (23 CM)

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## YARN COLORS

I USE BRAZILIAN BRANDS' YARNS - OUR DEFAULT SIZE MEASURES 1006/200M (217 YDS).

SINCE DIFFERENT COUNTRIES MEASURE IN DIFFERENT WAYS. YOU MAY HAVE TO CHECK YOUR YARN SIZE.

- GRAY YARN
- BLACK YARN

## EXTRA MATERIALS:

- ACRYLIC FIBER (TO STUFF)
- A PAIR OF BLUE SAFETY EYES (5MM)
- FABRIC GLUE
- WHITE FELT

## TOOLS:

- CROCHET HOOK (3.0MM)
- SCISSORS
- TAPESTRY NEEDLE

## TO MAKE THIS PATTERN YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- HOW TO MAKE A MAGIC CIRCLE (ALSO KNOWN AS MAGIC RING)
- CHAIN STITCH
- SLIP STITCH
- SINGLE CROCHET STITCH (TO INCREASE AND DECREASE)
- HOW TO CHANGE TO A DIFFERENT YARN COLOR

## PATTERN

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Rnd** = round

**St** = stitch

**Sc** = single crochet

**Sl st** = slip stitch

**Inc** = increase

**Dec** = decrease

**\*\*** = repeat instructions between asterisks

**( )** = number of total stitches by round

### EYES x2

Before starting crocheting, let's leave the eyes ready to be used in the next step. Cut two circles in the white felt. Make a small hole with the scissors and pass the safety eyes through it. Pay attention to the fact that the safety eyes are not aligned in the middle of the felt, they are placed closer to one side of the border. Check image #3 for the correct placement.

### HEAD/BODY

Gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 in magic circle (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: inc x12 (24)

Rnd 4: \*sc in the next 3 st, inc\* x6 (30)

Rnd 5: \*sc in the next 4 st, inc\* x6 (36)

Rnd 6: working in back loops only, sc in each st (36)

Rnd 7-14: sc in each st (36)

Rnd 15: working in back loops only, sc in each st (36)

Rnd 16: \*sc in the next 4 st, dec\* x6 (30)

Rnd 17: \*sc in the next 3 st, dec\* x6 (24)

Let's use the safety eyes with the felt from the previous step, putting them between the 9<sup>th</sup> and the 10<sup>th</sup> round.

Rnd 18: dec x12 (12)

Rnd 19: \*sc in the next st, dec\* x4 (8)

Stuff the head. Now, we are going to start the body.

Change to black yarn to do the neck.

Rnd 20-21: sc in each st (8)

Change to gray yarn.

Rnd 22: \*sc in the next st, inc\* x4 (12)

Rnd 23: inc x12 (24)

Rnd 24: \*sc in the next 3 st, inc\* x6 (30)

Rnd 25-29: sc in each st (30)

Change to black yarn.

Rnd 30: \*sc in the next 3 st, dec\* x6 (24)

Rnd 31: dec x12 (12)

Stuff the body and don't forget to do the same with the neck.

Rnd 32: dec x6 (6)

Using the tapestry needle, be sure to tightly close the last six stitches.

### LEGS X2

Before starting, please notice that we are working from the feet to the thighs, from the bottom to the upper part.

Black yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 in magic circle (6)

Rnd 2: inc x3 + sc in the next 3 st (9)

Rnd 3: inc x6 + sc in the next 3 st (15)

Change to gray yarn.

Rnd 4-5: sc in each st (15)

Rnd 6: dec x6 + sc in the next 3 st (9)

Rnd 7: sc in each st (9)

Change to black yarn again.

Rnd 8-13: sc in each st (9)

Finish off leaving a long tail to sew to the body later. Stuff.

### ARMS X2

Gray yarn.

Before starting, please notice that we are working from the hand to the shoulders, from the bottom to the upper part.

Rnd 1: 6 in magic circle (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3-6: sc in each st (12)

Rnd 7: dec x6 (6)

Change to black yarn.

Rnd 8-14: sc in each st (6)

Finish off, leaving a long tail to sew to the body later. Don't stuff. If you want to stuff, do it only with the arms, since the hands need to be empty inside so they are able to flex and also look like a robot's hands.

### FINGER x2

Gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 4 in magic circle (4)

Rnd 2-3: sc in each st (4)

Finish off, leaving a long tail to sew to the hands later. Don't stuff.

### ANTENNA

Gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 4 in magic circle (4)

Rnd 2-3: sc in each st (4)

Change to black yarn.

Rnd 4-6: sc in each st (4)

Rnd 7: \*sc in the next st, inc\* x2 (6)

Change to gray yarn again.

Rnd 8: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 9: sc in each st (12)

Rnd 10: \*sc in the next st, inc\* x6 (18)

Finish off, leaving a long tail to sew to the head later. Stuff (just a little).

### **EARS x2**

Gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 in magic circle (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: \*sc in the next st, inc\* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: working in back loops only, sc in each st (18)

Finish off, leaving a long tail to sew to the head later.

Stuff (just a little).

Check image #1 to see what you got so far.

### **DETAILS:**

Now that you have all the pieces, let's put them all together! Remember that to attach all the parts to the body, we are going to use the tapestry needle. All the tails must be hidden inside the body. My tip for placing the pieces always in a precise way: use pins to attach the pieces to the doll's body, so you will know exactly where to use the needle when sewing (remove the pins after that).

- Start sewing the legs. Be careful when sewing. Don't pull the thread too much to avoid it from looking like a separated body part.

- Sew both arms to the body and then the fingers to the hands. Check image #2.

- Now it's time to sew the antenna and the ears.

- Cut a piece of the black yarn to sew his mouth.

Check image #3.

- Use the fabric glue to attach the felt to the doll.

Congratulations! You now have a new friend!
